- Seek feedback from community on transition work.







Construction Update

- Installation of hollow-core precast is ongoing on second and third floors
- Roof precast on the north wing is installed
- Installation of structural steel in main hub and cafeteria ongoing
- Masonry work on north wing ongoing
- Installation electrical, plumbing and HVAC on the ground, second and third floors of the north wing are ongoing

- Feeder schools- Grade 7 & 8s transition plans


