Facility is progressing well overall in terms of our planned schedule

- Shear walls are at 90% (4 pours remaining not including stairs)
- First floor exterior masonry is 50% complete, second and third floors at 75%
- Structural steel is 90% complete
- Roofing to commence in next 2 weeks
- Aluminum frames at 20% with glass anticipated to show up this week
- Electrical, mechanical and HVAC rough-ins at 50%

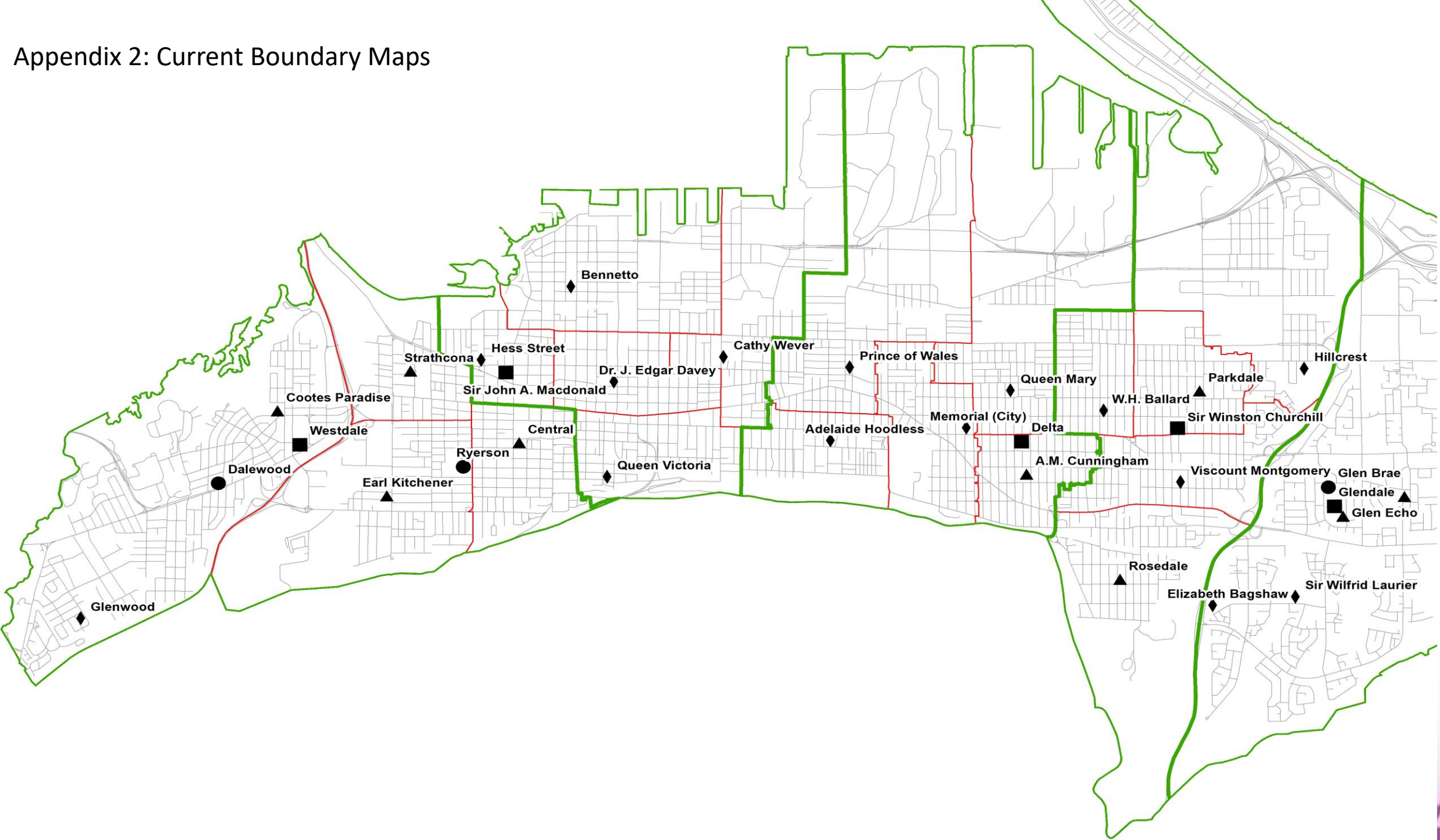

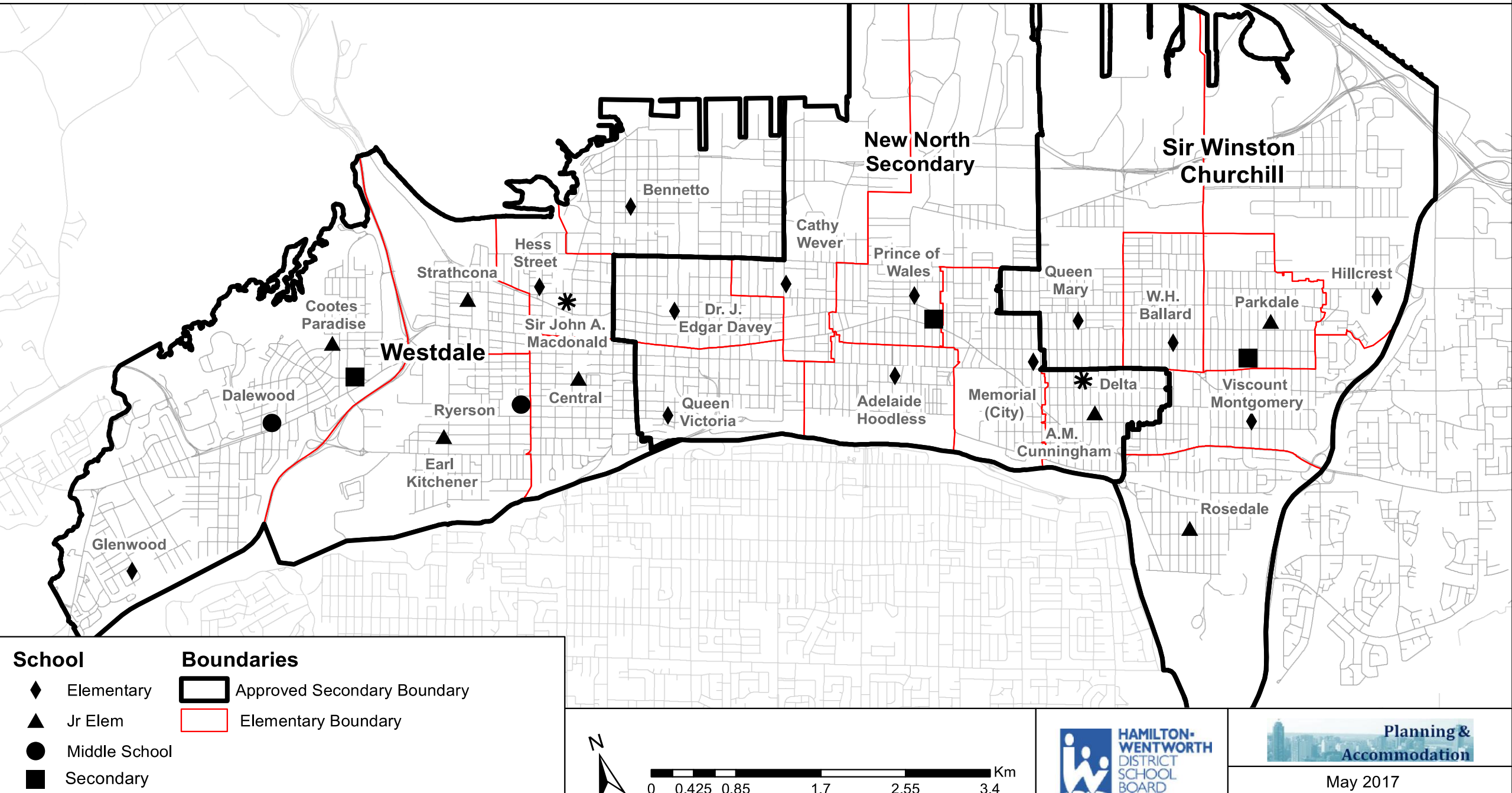
