## ZONE 3

Students move to new school on Eastdale site when construction is completed

## ZONE 4

Students remain at Mountain View and move to new school on Memorial SC site when construction is completed

## ZONE 5

Students move to new school on Memorial SC site when construction is completed

## ZONE 6

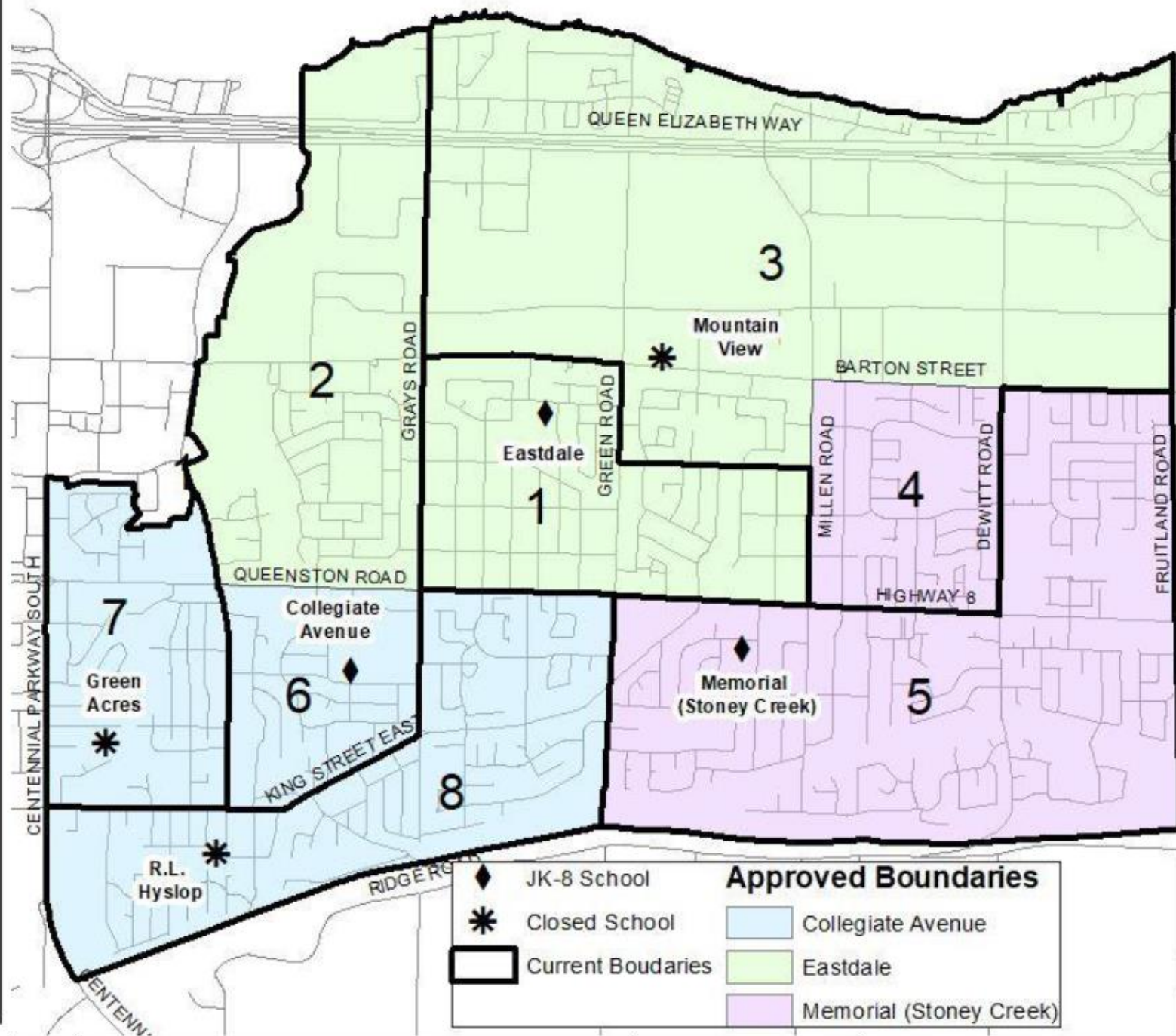
Students move to holding site (i.e. Green Acres/R.L. Hyslop) and return to school on Collegiate site when construction is completed

## ZONE 7

Students move to school on Collegiate site when construction is completed

## ZONE 8

Students move to school on Collegiate site when construction is completed



The Naming of Schools process **shall** begin under the following circumstances:

- Closure of two or more schools and consolidation into a new build on an existing or new site (Appendix B – New School on Eastdale Site)

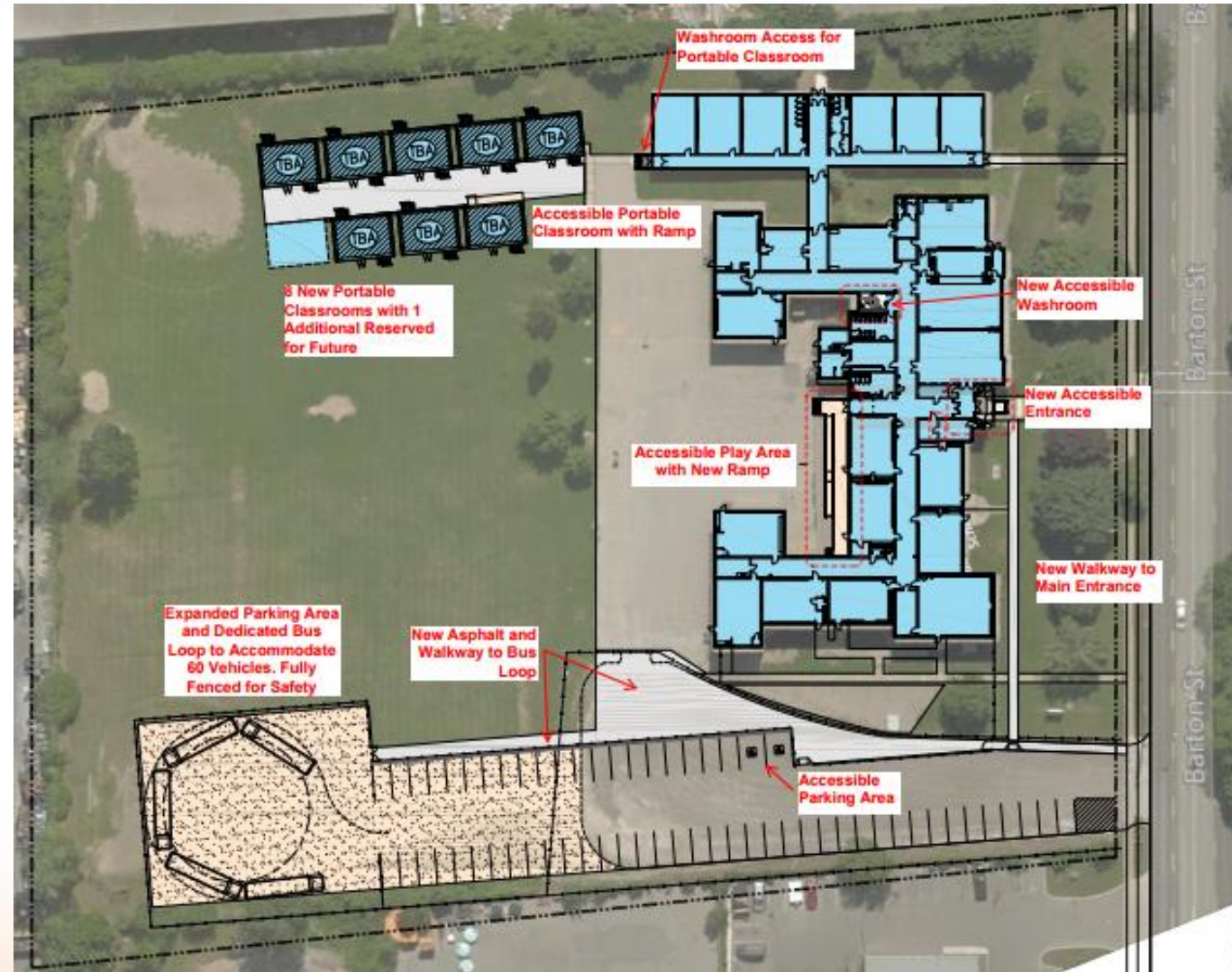
The Naming of Schools process **may** begin under the following circumstances, only if the affected schools would like to proceed and subsequent approval from the Board of Trustees. This is to be determined through discussion with the School Councils and Home & School Associations, where they may exist, of the affected schools:

- Closure of one or more schools and consolidation into an existing school (Appendix C)



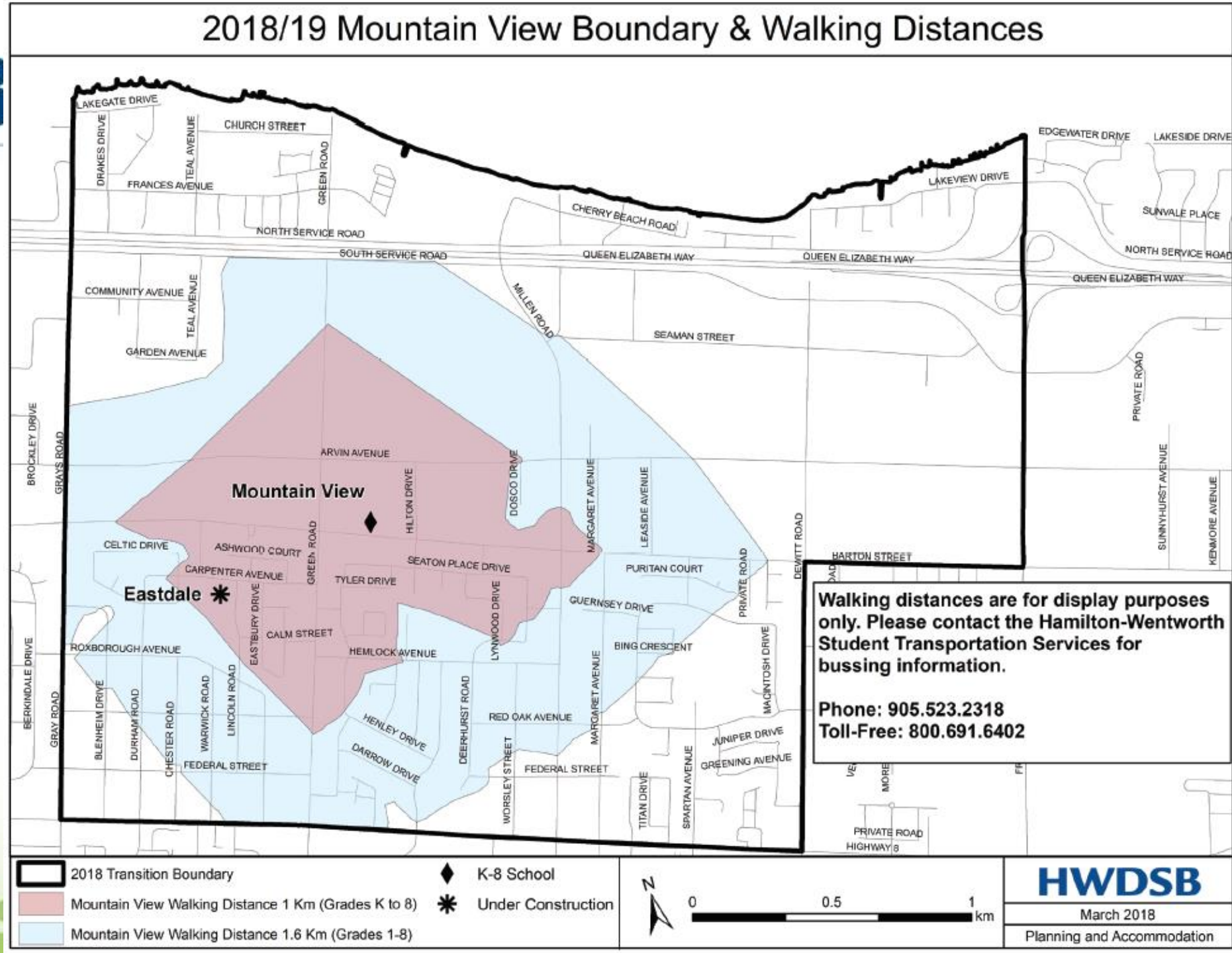
# HWDSB MOUNTAIN VIEW FACILITY UPDATE
