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ACCOMMODATION REVIEW RESOLUTION

On June 6, 2016, Trustees approved the following with respect to the Lower Stoney Creek Pupil Accommodation Review:

That Collegiate Avenue, Eastdale, Green Acres, Memorial (SC), Mountain View and R.L. Hyslop be closed pending Ministry of Education funding for three new JK-8 elementary schools on the Collegiate, Eastdale and Memorial (SC) sites.



MINISTRY FUNDING APPROVALS

On June 19, 2017 the Ministry announced funding for a new JK-8 elementary school for 495 students to be built on the existing Memorial SC site.


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SCHOOL CONSOLIDATION PLAN

Memorial SC students remain at the current Memorial School during construction of the new school and move when construction is complete. Following opening of the new school, the existing Memorial School will be closed and demolished.

Mountain View (Zone 4) students move from Mountain View to the new school on the grounds of the current Memorial site when construction is complete.

- 4 Kindergarten Rooms with access to secured outdoor play area
- Connected classes to promote team teaching and improved supervision

- 5500 square foot double gym

- Scoreboard
- Fixed Stage





LEARNING COMMONS

- Large open space
- Natural light
- Flexible seating/learning areas



MUSIC ROOM

- Area (sf): 1000
- Teaching wall with white board and interactive short throw projector
- Teacher coat & book storage cabinet
- Lockable full height cupboards with open adjustable shelving for instrument storage
- Large stainless steel sink for cleaning instruments and separate small sink for mouth piece sanitization


SCIENCE ROOM

New Elementary School Construction Timelines



- Project is currently in Municipal Approvals Phase
- School construction takes 12 18 months following Approvals Phase



TRANSITION PLANNING

If the Board of Trustees' decision is consolidation, closure or major program relocation, the following school year will be used to plan for and implement the Board's decision.

A separate advisory group (Transition Committee) will be established to address the transition for students and staff of the affected schools.
