Option #2

- Implemented in 2020 rather than 2019




HWDSB OPTION #2 – DELAYING BILLY GREEN BOUNDARY CHANGE

- Billy Green's enrolment would continue to grow until 2019
- Initially, Tapleytown's would be low but with the 2020 boundary change, all new families in the Nash Neighbourhood would attend Tapleytown beginning in 2020.



Option #1	 Does not address long term accommodation issues at Tapleytown. Does not address short term enrolment pressure at Billy Green – still 8 portables. Existing Nash neighbourhood families get to stay at Billy Green
Option #2	 Only a short term delay Does not effectively address accommodation concerns
Option #3	 Concerns with students crossing Mud Street to attend Janet Lee
General Feedback	 All Summit Park survey should attend new Summit Park school Review accommodation each year Second boundary review in 2020
