To parents, guardians, caregivers of Memorial Stoney Creek,

***Re: Construction of New School at the Memorial (SC) Site***

The Hamilton-Wentworth District School Board (HWDSB) has received \$12,039,902 from the Ministry of Education to build a new elementary school to replace the existing Memorial Stoney Creek School. This new school will accommodate students from Memorial and a portion of Mountain View School.

As part of this school consolidation plan, Memorial students will remain at the current Memorial School during construction of the new school and move when construction is complete. Following the opening of the new school, the existing Memorial School will be closed and demolished.

At the November 26, 2018 Board of Trustees meeting, staff presented results of a consultation with Stoney Creek residents living on Kilbourn Ave. adjacent to the proposed new school site. Residents provided feedback regarding the design and layout planned for the new school. All respondents were in support of the current design/layout that has been submitted for municipal approval (see below).



Following this consultation, construction of the new school on the Memorial Stoney Creek site is proceeding as planned based on the existing design and layout.
