HWDSB ACCOMMODATION REVIEW RESOLUTION

On June 6, 2016, Trustees approved the following with respect to the Lower Stoney Creek Pupil Accommodation Review:

That Collegiate Avenue, Eastdale, Green Acres, Memorial (SC), Mountain View and R.L. Hyslop be closed pending Ministry of Education funding for three new JK-8 elementary schools on the Collegiate, Eastdale and Memorial (SC) sites.

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HWDSB MINISTRY FUNDING APPROVALS

On October 28, 2016 the Ministry of Education announced funding for building of a **new JK-8 elementary school for 564 students to be built on the existing <u>Eastdale</u> site.**

On June 19, 2017 the Ministry announced funding for a **new JK-8 elementary school for 495 students to be built on the existing** <u>Memorial SC</u> **site**.

On June 19, 2017 the Ministry announced funding for **an addition to** <u>Collegiate Ave. Elementary School to accommodate</u> 213 students.



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UPCOMING TRANSITIONS

Transition 1

Zone 2 students move to holding site at Green Acres and Zone 6 students move to R.L. Hyslop following the closure of Collegiate Ave. (June 30, 2019).


Transition 2

Zones 1, 2 & 3 move to new school at Eastdale site (Jan. – Mar. 2020)

Transition 3

Zone 4 moves to new school at Memorial site following the closure of Mountain View.

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HWDSB TRANSITION PLANNING

If the Board of Trustees' decision is consolidation, closure or major program relocation, the following school year will be used to plan for and implement the Board's decision.

A separate advisory group (Transition Committee) will be established to address the transition for students and staff of the affected schools.

Pupil Accommodation Review Procedure for Policy # 2.5

HWDSB TRANSITION COMMITTEE

- The Transition Committee provides advice to support a smooth and successful transition for all students, staff and families.
- Transition Committees are led by the Superintendent of Student Achievement in partnership with the school Principal and Vice-Principal.
- Transition Committees typically have a series of meetings prior to the commencement of the planned transition.

HWDSB TRANSITION COMMITTEE

Transition Committees provide advice on a variety of matters including:

- Artefacts and/or traditions to be incorporated into the new school
- School renaming based on Naming of Schools Policy # 2.3
- Activities to support students and families prior to actual move
- Opening/closing ceremonies

HWDSB TRANSITION COMMITTEE

Transition Committees are typically composed of the following representatives from <u>each</u> affected school:

- Principal & Vice-Principal
- 1 Student
- 1 Teacher, 1 Learning Resource Teacher & 1 Support Staff Member
- 1 School Council Member & 1 Home & School Association Member
- 1 Parent Representative
- 1 Community Partner
- 1 Special Education Advisory Council Member (SEAC)
- Area Trustee

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HWDSB NAMING OF SCHOOLS PROCESS

The Naming of Schools process <u>shall</u> be initiated for the closure of two or more schools and consolidation into a new build on an existing or new site (Policy 2.3).

1	45 Day Consultation	Survey to gather suggested	Jan. – Mar.
2	Naming Advisory Committee	Provides report to Board of Trustees listing up to three names from consultation process.	Mar Apr
3	Board of Trustees Decision	Consider the report of the Naming Advisory Committee	May - June
