International Baccalaureate Programme Application Procedure September 2019 Registration

- 1. Submission of the following documentation by the application to the IB Coordinator must include:
 - a. Completion of the IB Biographical Data Sheet
 - b. Completion of the Parent Questionnaire
 - c. Completion of the Student Questionnaire
 - d. Copy of your Status Sheet (only if you don't currently attend Ancaster or Westdale)
 - e. A post dated cheque dated September 3, 2019 in the amount of \$600.

Please note: the IBDP currently has a cost of \$600 per semester over the total 4 semesters of the programme. Fees can fluctuate based on the strength of the Canadian dollar. Should fees need to be altered, this will be communicated to families in a timely manner.

The deadline for application submission is Friday, January 18, 2019

Note: if you have any concerns regarding the financial commitment of the IBDP please contact your IB school principal. A payment plan as well as financial aid is available for students in need. All matters will be handled with the strictest of confidence and privacy.

2. All applications will be reviewed and letters of acceptance, along with school-specific IB Option sheets will be sent out by **Monday, February 4, 2019**. If you have any questions regarding your application or the process please contact your designated IB school coordinator. Option sheets will be due back to your designated IB school by **Thursday**, **February 28, 2019**.

September 8, 2020


