CALL FOR AUDITIONS!

The Art Smart program is based at Sir Allan MacNab Secondary School. Students from secondary schools across the district will attend Sir Allan MacNab for their second semester. Students will be enrolled in specialized drama, voice, instrumental, dance, and musical theatre courses. Opportunities are also available for students interested in set and costume design, lighting and technical support. Classes are enriched by a partnership with Theatre Ancaster and other community partners with an afternoon co-op preparing a full-scale musical production.

To be eligible for this unique program, students must:

1. be 15 years of age or older;
2. have successfully completed a minimum of 8 credits
3. submit all required application information by the due date
4. attend an interview session, if requested

Audition Information:

Auditions will be held at *Sir Allan MacNab* on **September 18 and September 19 from 3 to 7 p.m.** in the Auditorium.

How to prepare:

- Book an audition and receive your scheduled time. Please book online at <https://sam-aud.parentinterview.com>
- Bring a completed application form (found at www.hwdsb.on.ca)
- Students should come prepared with a monologue (*memorized if possible*)
- Students should come with a song prepared to sing (*karaoke accompaniment is strongly suggested. Docking stations/speakers will be available for cellphones, tablets etc.*)
- Those students with a dance background can prepare a short piece of choreography that demonstrates their abilities
- Those students who are interested in the technical side of the program should bring a portfolio of their work and experience connected to the performance industry. Students should have an idea as to how they would like to be involved in the program (*for example; lighting, sound, costume design etc.*)

Please be advised of the following policies:

- Selection of students will be based on suitability of candidates
- Students are not guaranteed acceptance to the program by submitting an application
