

Countdown to **Kindergarten**

Kindergarten is an exciting, enriching place where children spend two years learning to explore the world, solve problems and make friends. A teacher and early childhood educator combine as a caring team to help your child get the best start in school!

How to register for Kindergarten, which is a two-year program:

- 1. Your child is **eligible for Kindergarten in the year they turn four or five**. Your child must attend school if they are age six by September 1.
- 2. Register at your closest HWDSB school, located online at www.hwdsb.on.ca/parents/find or by calling 905-527-5092. We have introduced online registration find this at www.hwdsb.on.ca/kindergarten
- 3. Only parents or legal guardians can register their children for school. The following documents are required: Proof of age (child's birth certificate or passport); Proof of residency (identification that shows parent/guardian's current home address); Proof of immunization; Verification of date of arrival/immigration documents (if the child was not born in Canada).
- 4. At registration, please tell staff if you have any concerns about your child starting school. We have many resources to support language development, behaviour concerns and special needs in the classroom.
- 5. Hamilton-Wentworth Student Transportation Services (HWSTS) provides transportation for eligible HWDSB Kindergarten students. Eligible students receive an eligibility letter from HWSTS in early summer. Our First Rider program gives students a chance to ride the bus during the summer. - 6. Some schools offer fee for service before- and after-school child care programs. Find locations at www.hwdsb.on.ca/kindergarten/childcare. A fee subsidy may be available at https://bit.ly/feesubsidy
