Committee Mandate

The Transition Committee will review:

- French Immersion boundaries for the new program;
- Timelines and enrollment projections:
- Transition activities for students as they prepare to change schools and/or enter a new French Immersion program;
- Transportation information and potential issues;
- Accommodation and program issues providing any recommendations do not exceed the overall funding available to the school or contravene City, Board and/or Ministry requirements.

Guiding Principles

- Engaging program
- Balanced and healthy enrolment in both FI and Regular Track programs
- Reduced reliance on portable classrooms
- Preferred K-8 model for elementary schools*
- Equity of access, opportunity and distribution of programs

*While having fewer and more effective transitions for students in elementary schools is our goal, HWDSB facilities restrict our ability to implement the preferred K-8 model in all schools.



Background: FI Boundary Review

The French Immersion Boundary Review took place for East Hamilton and Lower Stoney Creek in the fall of 2017.

A board motion was approved unanimously on December 18, 2017 to set the new boundaries. (see next slide)

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Board Motion December 18, 2017


- ✓ That the French Immersion programs at Glen Echo (grades 1-5) and Glen Brae (grade 6-8) be relocated to Parkdale (grades 1-5) and W.H. Ballard (grades 6-8) and A.M. Cunningham (grade 1-5) and the new school on Eastdale (grades 1-8) be approved based on the boundaries and move the Sir Wilfrid Laurier English catchment into the Parkdale / W. H. Ballard French Immersion Stream.
- ✓ Further, Grade 1 French Immersion is to begin at Parkdale and Green Acres (while Eastdale is being constructed) for September 2018 and that staff engage with affected school communities and return to trustees with a transition plan for current grade 1-7 students at Glen Brae and Glen Echo.

Background: FI Transition

In the winter of 2018, we began an FI transition advisory process and public consultation, which resulted in an updated board motion on February 26, 2018. (see next slides)

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Board Motion: February 26, 2018

- ✓ French Immersion students currently attending Glen Echo and Glen Brae will remain at Glen Echo and Glen Brae until June 2020
- ✓ French Immersion students attending AM Cunningham (Gr. 1-5) will continue at AM Cunningham and attend Glen Brae (Gr. 6-8) until June 2020
- ✓ Newly accepted Gr. 1 French Immersion students living within the new East Hamilton (Parkdale) and Lower Stoney Creek (Green Acres/Eastdale) French Immersion catchments will attend Glen Echo for the 2018-19 school year.

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Board Motion: February 26, 2018


- ✓ Gr. 1 French Immersion will continue at Glen Echo until June 2020 and be relocated to Parkdale and the new school at the Eastdale site by September 2020.
- ✓ After June 2020, all French Immersion students attending Glen Echo and Glen Brae will relocate to the new sites identified through the East Hamilton Lower Stoney Creek French Immersion Boundary Review for September 2020
 - ✓ New East Hamilton FI Schools Parkdale (Gr. 1-5), WH Ballard (Gr. 6-8)
 - ✓ New Lower Stoney Creek FI School New School at Eastdale Site (Gr. 1-8)

Background

Schools Affected:

- A.M. Cunningham (grade 1-5) continues with small change in FI boundary – feeds to W.H. Ballard instead of Glen Brae
- Eastdale (grade 1-8) new FI program opens
- Glen Echo and Glen Brae FI program relocated and schools closed for new build.
- Parkdale (grade 1-5) FI program opens
- W.H. Ballard (grade 6-8) FI program opens





HWDSB Transportation Policy

"Students residing in all urban and rural areas as defined by the City of Hamilton Official Plan will be eligible for transportation services to their in-catchment school when the walking distance exceeds the following:

- Kindergarten 1.2 km
- Grades 1-8 1.6 km
- French Immersion using Community Stops"



HWDSB Transportation Procedure

"The method of transportation for elementary French Immersion will be:

- Grade 1 Black and Yellow Buses with community stops, for those that meet the French Immersion Application deadline.
- Grade 2 to 6 Black and Yellow Buses with community stops.
- Grade 7 and 8 HSR (unless there is an existing route that accommodates these students).

Where HSR is not available, alternative transportation will be provided."

- Communication with families
- Board supports for French Immersion programs
- Preparation for Eastdale, Parkdale, W.H. Ballard staff to welcome a new program and create English/French environment.
- Activities for current students at Glen Echo and Glen Brae to welcome them to new schools.
- French Immersion Staffing: Human Resources process
