Dear Families,

It has been six weeks since the Ministerial Order closed schools across Ontario. Distance Learning (Phase 2) has just finished its third week. This period remains a challenge for students, staff and families, but we are also hearing stories of connection, collaboration and success.

We are still awaiting a date for the reopening of Ontario schools, but we do know that we will not return on May 4, based on comments from the Premier of Ontario.

# Partnership with Public Health

Our community continues to do its part to combat COVID-19, whether by staying at home, donating funds or providing supplies. After Hamilton Public Health Services asked local institutions to contribute medical supplies, HWDSB has, to date, provided more than 85,000 gloves, 1,300 face masks, 40 face shields and 20 3D printers.

#### **Graduations and Celebrations**

**Secondary:** This week, we shared a letter with Grade 12 graduating students informing them that we had to cancel athletics, proms, banquets and similar events for the remainder of this school year. We have also had to cancel secondary school graduations in June, as we consider future dates after public health permits large gatherings. We apologize and share the disappointment felt by our impacted students and families, but this difficult and necessary decision was guided by public health recommendations.

**Elementary:** Unfortunately, we must also cancel year-end elementary school gatherings, including Grade 8 graduations. We are exploring alternative options to honour these important milestones and will share more information in the weeks ahead.

# **NEW Ministry of Education Updates**

Assessment, Evaluation and Reporting: On April 7, we communicated direction about secondary grades based on a Ministry of Education memo dated March 31, 2020. We apologize for any confusion or anxiety this may have caused our students, families and staff. The Ministry has since provided clarity to school boards. Grades and marks will not go down from what they were on March 13, 2020. This applies to elementary and secondary school students.
