Public Property Assessment Network Scholarship

The Public Property Assessment Network Scholarship in the amount of \$1,000 is being awarded to one recipient of Ontario Public School Boards' Association's (OPSBA's) Central West Region. Scholarship recipients are students of strong character, leadership skills and potential, who care deeply about their communities and furthering their own learning.

Who Can Apply?

Eligible Students must be:

- A Canadian citizen or permanent resident
- In good standing academically and non-academically with their secondary school
- Entering a post-secondary program within Ontario in 2020
- Graduating from a secondary school within one of the eligible school boards or school authorities within the Central West Region.

- Niagara Children's Centre School Authority
- Peel District School Board

Who are we looking for?

Selection Criteria will consider, but is not limited to:

- Academic achievement and/or standing
- Contribution to the life of the school through extracurricular and/or volunteer activities
- Pursuing post-secondary education in Ontario
- Social identity, socio-economic status or other factors unique to each student's achievements and the opportunities available to them
- Receipt of other major awards or scholarships

Application Process

Applicants are asked to explain in a **maximum** of 300 words their suitability for the Public Property Assessment Network Scholarship based on the established Selection Criteria.

All applications must be accompanied by **two letters of reference**, one of which must be from the applicant's school principal or principal designate on school letterhead. Letters of reference should not exceed two pages in length.

*Note: To ensure a fair selection process, any additional materials/letters and/or submissions beyond the word limit will **not be taken into consideration**.
