Camp Power Learning Happens Through Play!

Campers will be introduced to books and learning opportunities for 2 hours of live-teaching or synchronous learning. This is a highly interactive time where students will initiate areas of interest and teachers will respond offering Indigenous teachings with visitors sharing their knowledge, traditions, customs and beliefs.

A third hour each day is for asynchronous learning. These are extra extension activities to the morning's learning such as outdoor fitness, scavenger hunts, family storytelling, kitchen science, creating with recyclables and writing letters to hometown heroes and loved ones.
