

Applicants have the option to audition in person or an audition on MS Teams.

For MS Teams Auditions please follow these guidelines:

- Your camera angle must include the actor's entire body. The audition panel must be able to see your face and eyes clearly to properly assess the student's technique.
- Before your performance task, please introduce what you will be presenting. For example, "Hello. My name is...I will be presenting Papa's 'For A Highway' from Michael A Miller's El Paso."
- We will share with you a Cold Read during the audition
 - You will be given a moment to read through the short series of lines before presenting this "cold"
 - We could redirect you and ask you to do the lines differently
- There will be a short interview asking questions about your interest in drama, the program, what you want to get from the program and your background in your art discipline

Please do the following to prepare for your performance task:

- Read through the **Drama Monologues 2020 package** and choose the monologue that you feel most comfortable in presenting – ALL MONOLOGUES PRESENTED ARE FROM THIS PACKAGE ONLY!
- Research the play that the monologue is from. Use what happens before and after to help you create your character
- Memorize your lines and blocking for your monologue.
- Wear all black clothing or a costume with props that are appropriate to the scen
