



ABPA - DANCE PERFORMANCE AUDITION REQUIREMENTS

Applicants have the option to audition in person or submit a video audition.

Performance Task:

For your dance audition, there is no advanced preparation required (except attending your regular dance classes at the studio, this is the best method to prepare for the audition).

Dance is ONE (1) group audition, with individual interviews following. The group audition will be a Jazz combination, taught by the instructor, learned on the spot and then performed in smaller groups. At the end of the audition, an opportunity to showcase any further abilities/styles will be given, in the form of improvisation.

Criteria that will be assessed at the audition are as follows:

- Ability to pick up and perform choreography learned on the spot
- Musicality
- Technical Ability
- Improvisational Skills
- Performance Ability
- Artistic Potential

For video submissions, please follow these guidelines:

- ONE (1) video that is in the style of Jazz Dance. This can be a solo, duet, trio or group routine. Please provide clear details of which dancer they are in the video.
- ONE (1) video that is in the style of your strongest dance style. This can be a solo, duet, trio or group routine. Please provide clear details of which dancer they are in the video.

Criteria that will be assessed from the videos are as follows:

- Musicality
- Technical Ability
- Performance Ability
- Artistic Potential
