

A separate advisory group (Transition Committee) will be established to address the transition for students and staff of the affected schools.

HWDSB ACCOMMODATION REVIEW RESOLUTION

On June 6, 2016, Trustees approved the following with respect to the East Hamilton City 2 Pupil Accommodation Review:


That Elizabeth Bagshaw, Glen Brae, Glen Echo and Sir Isaac Brock be closed pending Ministry of Education funding for a new JK-8 elementary school on the Glendale Campus and that the boundaries between the new Glendale Campus School and Sir Wilfrid Laurier be modified.



HWDSB MINISTRY FUNDING APPROVALS

On June 19, 2017 the Ministry of Education announced funding to build a new 682 pupil place, JK - 8 elementary school beside Glen Brae School.

This new school will accommodate students from Elizabeth Bagshaw, Glen Brae, Glen Echo, Sir Isaac Brock and Sir Wilfrid Laurier.



SCHOOL TRANSITION PLAN

Elizabeth Bagshaw, Glen Brae, Glen Echo and Sir Isaac Brock schools will close at the end of June 2021.

The new school being built beside Glen Brae will open on September 2021.

Sir Wilfrid Laurier will begin September 2021 with a new boundary.

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ZONE 1

All Glen Echo and Glen Brae (Regular Track) students move to the new school on the Glen Brae site. Glen Echo School to be closed. Glen Brae School to be closed and demolished.

ZONE 2

All Sir Isaac Brock students move to the new school on the Glen Brae site. Sir Isaac Brock School to be closed.

ZONE 3

Sir Wilfrid Laurier students move to the new school on the Glen Brae site.


ZONE 4

Elizabeth Bagshaw students move to the new school on the Gien Brae site. Elizabeth Bagshaw School to be closed.

ZONE 5

Elizabeth Bagshaw students move to Sir Wilfrid Laurier School. Elizabeth Bagshaw School to be closed.


ZONE 6 Sir Wilfrid Laurier students remain at. Sir Wilfrid Laurier School.

 Students living within Sir Wilfrid Laurier (Zone 3) and Elizabeth Bagshaw (Zone 4)will move to new Glen School for September 2021.




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
SCHOOL TRANSITION PLAN
