- Demonstrate Financial need

In addition to showing proof of the criteria listed above, the student applicant is required to demonstrate, in the form of short responses, to the following questions:

1. What have you learned about yourself during the pandemic? (150 words max)
2. What are your plans for building a better future for yourself and for society? (250 words Max)
3. What charity would you donate to today, and why? (150 words max)

Documentation and Deadline: submit written proof of the above criteria and completed answers to info@brownfinancial.com. Applications, complete with supporting documentation, are to be received no later than 5 p.m. on Friday, June 11, 2021.

*Oral Responses may be submitted as an alternative where necessary

**Students pursuing post-secondary education on a part-time basis are normally not eligible for consideration. Recipients must be accepted by a college or university and begin attending in September of 2021.
