ABPA Drama Audition Requirements 2022-2023

Applicants will audition via filmed performance. Interview portion will take place on Microsoft Teams.

For your performance video submission, please follow these guidelines:

- Your camera angle must include your entire body. We need to see your face and eyes clearly to properly assess your technique.
- Before you begin your performance, please introduce what you are performing. For example, "Hello my name is ______, and I will be performing the monologue "The Time Hunters" by Rodrigo Smith."
- Performance options are a monologue from our website, or a storytelling/poetry performance of your choice.
- You will find the monologues and video examples at https://glendalepa.commons.hwdsb.on.ca/
- You will receive an invitation to a brief Microsoft Teams meeting where the audition panel will ask you questions about your interest in drama, the program, and how you prepared for the filmed audition. If you are currently an HWDSB student, you will use your school email. Otherwise please check the email you provided us with on your application.

Please do the following to prepare for your performance:

- Read through the Drama Monologues package 2022-2023 and choose the monologue that you feel most comfortable in presenting – ALL MONOLOGUES PRESENTED ARE FROM THIS PACKAGE ONLY.
- Memorize your lines and blocking (movement) for your monologue.
- Wear regular clothing (black suggested) <u>or</u> a costume with props that are appropriate to the scene.
- Alternate option: Storytelling/Poetry please prepare an original story or poem performance (2-3 mins in length) for submission. Video examples will be found on the website. This option must be written by the applicant.
