Tech Requirements:

Sound- Create Playlist with **Free Content** from simple site like **Youtube**

Your task:

First - Read over the script to familiarize yourself with the scene.

Second - Create a playlist of music and sound effects that you think are appropriate to the scene. Put them in order of play next to the text in the monologue (you can include links for them as well if you can find free ones (sound effects) or Youtube links for the songs.

Third - Using the light-lab software create TWO lighting scenes using one of the people offered in the software. Light them and the back ground as you see fit to match the mood, highlight what you believe is important for the audience according to what is going on in the scene. One lighting scheme (minimum) for each paragraph of the script. You can use more - just tell us where in the script the lighting will change. SCREENSHOT your final design for each lighting scheme.

Fourth - Send us a copy of the script above with notations of where the sounds/songs are to be played, as well as the when your lighting changes. Send a separate word document with the song/sound links in order as well as your screenshots of lighting in order.
