

Dear Interested Student Trustee Candidates:

The process for determining the Student Trustees for the 2022 - 2023 Hamilton-Wentworth District School Board is in three parts:

1. Submission of Completed Interest Form by Thursday, January 20th, 2022 by 4 pm
2. Student Trustee Election Candidate questions (the videos) due by Monday, February 7th, 2022 by 4 pm
3. Student Trustee Election Candidate profiles will be posted to the website February 14th – 18th, 2022.
4. Election of the new Student Trustees will take electronically this year from February 18th – 25th, 2022 - all students in grades 7 - 12 will have an opportunity to vote for their top 2 candidates – each school will submit a final ballot for their top 2 voted candidates as selected by the school population.

A final Board report will be submitted to the Board of Trustees for ratification in March 2022.

The new Student Trustees will be asked to attend the **Ontario Student Trustees' Association Conference** in **May 2021** along with the outgoing Student Trustees.
