

Transitioning from Youth to Adult Services

What happens to my services when I turn 18?



When you turn 18, you are considered to be an adult. Children's services such as Special Services at Home, Assistance for Children with Severe Disabilities or services through the Ontario Autism Program end.

You must apply to Developmental Services Ontario (DSO) to see if you are eligible for adult developmental services.
