

Applicants will perform in person at Glendale Secondary School with the option of using a piano during their performance. Please refer to the Admission Timelines for dates.

Performance tasks:

For your vocal audition, please prepare two contrasting pieces. We recommend one of them be from the Musical Theatre genre. Please source and bring accompaniment tracks for both songs. The acceptable format for the tracks is a mp3 sent to abpa@hwdsb.on.ca with your Name and Piece Title in the Subject line before the audition date [if not received beforehand we assume that you are singing acapella – not recommended]. We ask that you bring a copy of the sheet music you are using for the panel to use as well.

Additional musicianship skills will be tested during your audition.
