FOR STUDENTS IN GRADES JK to 8

Summer INTERNATIONAL LANGUAGE Programs

Summer International Language Programs provide an opportunity for students in Elementary School to develop and/or maintain the ability to speak, listen, read and write in a new language or the language of their heritage.

Program runs July 2 to 26, 2024

- Enhances students' connection with their heritage.
- Improves communication skills in their language of choice.
- Strengthens cognitive development through the knowledge of an additional language.
- Provides opportunities to learn and experience another culture.

Eligibility: Students eligible to attend an Ontario Elementary school in the 2023-2024 school year are eligible to attend one class in each available language for FREE¹. Additional classes in the same language are available for a fee of \$125 per student per additional course. VISA students are able to participate for a fee of \$125 per course.

FOR STUDENTS ENTERING GRADE 9 IN SEPTEMBER 2024

REACH AHEAD (On-Line) Credit Program

Summer Reach Ahead programs provide Grade 8 students an opportunity to earn a credit in the summer before their Grade 9 year. In July 2024, we are offering Civics and/or Careers (On-Line) and Technology Education courses. Participating in Summer Reach Ahead programs helps to keep your student learning and engaged through the summer and enhances their progression experience as they move to Secondary School. Civics and Careers courses will be available in both English and French.

Eligibility: Current Grade 8 students are eligible to take one Technology course OR Civics and/or Careers^{1,4}

SUMMER SCHOOL (On-Line) Credit Program

Continuing Education is pleased to offer Full Credit courses through our On-Line Summer School programs.

Eligibility: Students currently in grade 9-12 and Adult learners are eligible to attend^{4,5}
