- Facility questions





#### Board Approved Motion (February 10, 2025)

- A. That the geographic area described on the map below is moved from Eastdale's English program boundary to Collegiate's English program.
- B. That the boundary change is effective September 1, 2025.
- C. That all new and existing grade JK to 4 English students in the identified boundary change area move from Eastdale to Collegiate.



# Review of the Approved Boundary





Board Approved Motion (February 10, 2025) (continued)

D. That existing grade 5, 6 and 7 English students attending Eastdale and residing in the identified boundary change area may remain at Eastdale until the completion of grade 8. As of ratification of this motion, all younger siblings of existing grade 5, 6, and 7 students residing in the identified boundary change area and attending Eastdale may choose to attend either Eastdale or Collegiate in September 2025, and younger siblings who remain at Eastdale will be treated as out-of-catchment Eastdale students.



#### Board Approved Motion (February 10, 2025) (continued)

E. All existing out-of-catchment students attending Collegiate may continue to attend Collegiate under the out-of-catchment practice. All siblings of existing out-of-catchment students may attend Collegiate in accordance with Hamilton-Wentworth District School Board's Out-Of-Catchment Process. F. That a Transition Committee is struck upon approval of a boundary change by the Superintendent of Equity Student Achievement.

G. All student transportation will be provided in accordance with Hamilton-Wentworth District School Board's Transportation Policy No.3.10.



Students who may remain at Eastdale until completion of Grade 8 (additional details)

- If the student is currently in grades 5, 6 or 7 and chooses to remain at Eastdale, the student will qualify for transportation as per HWDSB's Transportation Policy 3.10. 2.
- If the student is currently in JK-4 and has a sibling in grade 5, 6 or 7 and chooses to remain at Eastdale, the student will be treated as Out of Catchment and will not qualify for transportation in 2025/26.
- Siblings in grades JK-4 who remain at Eastdale may qualify for courtesy transportation as per HWDSB's Transportation Policy 3.10.
