Attention Parents/Guardians:

Hamilton Public Health Services will be offering community vaccination clinics throughout the 2025 summer months. These clinics are intended for:

- Students in grade 7 to 12 who have missed or were unable to receive the grade 7 Hepatitis B, Human Papillomavirus (HPV-9), and Meningitis vaccinations provided at school.
- Individuals who do not have an Ontario Health Card and are unable to receive routine childhood vaccinations with a family health care provider or walk-in clinic.

There are 2 locations this summer where we will be hosting community clinics:

- East End Public Health Clinic located at 247 Centennial Pkwy N, Unit 8. All routine childhood vaccinations are available at this clinic.
- Chedoke Twin Pads Arena located at 91 Chedmac Drive. This clinic is intended for the catch up of grade 7 to 12 students who are missing their Hepatitis B, HPV and Meningitis vaccinations.
