I am excited to share an important update about the future of our Waterdown elementary school communities. We're preparing for the opening the new elementary school in Waterdown, scheduled for the 2027-2028 school year. To get ready, we have launched a boundary review process to help determine who will attend each school once the new building opens.

This process was officially approved by our Board of Trustees on May 5, 2025, and it's a key step in ensuring our schools are well-balanced, welcoming, and ready to meet the needs of all learners. Boundary reviews help us plan for growth, support evolving programs, and make the best use of our school spaces.

## What's Happening Next?

We have formed a Boundary Review Advisory Panel made up of representatives from each affected school. Their first meeting will take place on **October 30, 2025, at 4:30 PM** at **Guy B. Brown Elementary School**. This group will review school data and explore the proposed boundary options. There is also a second advisory panel meeting scheduled for **November 13, 2025, at 4:30 PM** at **Guy B. Brown Elementary School**.

We also want to hear from you! Please join us for a **Public Open House** on **November 27, 2025, at 5:30 PM to 7:30 PM at Waterdown Secondary School Gymnasium**. This will be a great opportunity to learn more about the boundary review, ask questions, and share your thoughts.
