Who can apply?

You can apply for the REaL camps if:

- → You are a current high school student (Grade 9 to 12). If you have passed Grade 8 and are entering Grade 9 in September 2025, you are eligible.
- + Language requirement: Students must be proficient in the English language.
- → You have permission from your parents or legal guardians to participate in this program.
- → You are able to commute to the camp location (university mentioned above) on all camp days.
- + You are either a domestic student or an international student with a valid visa.



Submit application

Important: Each camp has only 30 spots, so apply early. If you are accepted, we will let you know which camp(s) you have been selected for and send you a link to complete payment and secure your spot.

Application Process

- Step 1: Create a Loom Account
- Go to <u>loom.com</u> and sign up for a free account.
- Step 2: Record a Short Video (2 minutes max.)

- Answer these questions in your video:

(a) What motivates you to be part of the REaL program?; and (b) What makes you a good fit?

- **Step 3:** Share Your Video Link. Once your video is recorded, *copy* the shareable link.
- □ **Step 4:** Complete the Application Form

Paste your video link into the form, fill in the rest of the information, and follow the instructions in the form.

Each 5-day camp will take place entirely **in-person** at the mentioned university campus. Starting in the morning, each day will be packed with fun learning and interaction opportunities, Virtual Reality experiences, regular breaks, an hour-long lunch break and an early end to the day. You can apply to as many camps as you want to participate in (indicate your preference for the camps in the application). You will be responsible for commuting to and from the camp location (university mentioned above) on all camp days.
