RE: Support Staff Recruitment

OCTU – We have rolling recruitment for specific positions on an as needed basis when we have a vacancy. Usually once a year we do a general hiring to populate our supply list. This fall we added 29 individuals to the supply list.

Action

CUPE – We have a rolling recruitment on an as needed basis, postings go out once per month for available vacancies. We are currently scheduled for a blitz hiring for our casual list and anticipate interviews later this month.

COPE – We are continually recruiting for qualified Educational Assistant staff. In the summer we added 50 individuals to our supply list and are currently short listing the next group of applicants for interview.

DECE – Recruit for vacancies as they become available; this summer we added 12 to the supply list and as classes opened up this fall we added 10 FTE in new positions.

ESL - On an as needed basis

PSSP – Rolling recruitment on an as needed basis by discipline.
