# Principal's Corner

Winter has come to Yorkview and it's been ...cold! While we want students enjoying the outdoors every day, the freezing temperatures at the end of January made that impossible. Please continue to send your children with appropriate outdoor clothing as we will be outside unless the temperature is -15 C, or -20 C with wind chill.

With the cold weather, we must continue to be especially mindful of safety each morning and afternoon when dropping off and picking up. The safest environment is created when everyone follows the signs in our parking lot. There is no Kiss 'N Ride. When in the parking lot motorists should park their vehicle and not try to drop off near the front door. If a parking space is not available, there are always spots on the street. Our school is also in No Idling Zone. This reduces both environmental pollution and the negative effects upon the children from exhaust fumes. Most people are surprised to learn that children are more vulnerable to breathing in polluted air than adults. For their size, children breathe more air each minute than an adult and their reduced height makes them much closer to exhaust fumes. This is especially the case for babies or toddlers who visit the school in strollers or are carried around in portable car seats, but we also have kindergarten students outside the front playing daily.

This month's newsletter contains reminders of school routines and procedures. Please take the time to review them carefully. Your cooperation helps provide the necessary structures for students to learn and grow! Thank –you.

- 1. School Staff: Principal, LRT (Special Education Teacher), Classroom Teacher, Early Childhood Educator,
- 2. System Staff: Special Education Consultant, Psychoeducational Consultant, Special Assignment Teacher, Social Worker, Speech and Language Pathologist,
- 3. Community Partners: Speech Therapist, Occupational Therapist, and Physiotherapist.
