- 2. Reading the Dish with One Spoon Land Acknowledgement to start meeting
- 3. Approval of Previous Minutes (Dec 19 2018) approved
- 4. Approval of Current Agenda- approved
- 5. HWDSB Facility Manager Mr. Bob Avery-ravery@hwdsb.on.ca
 - -Mr Avery works under umbrella of VFA- an independent company employed by HWDSB which tracks lifespan of building components (eg boiler, windows, roof) and monitors ready to be replaced
 - -Issues brought forward for discussion included:
 - 1)gymnasium painting will be happening Jan 25. Walls only will be done at this tie. During the summer asbestos removal, LED lighting and ceiling work will be completed 2)AC concerns- we learned that we are not able to put AC in only one classroom unless there is a staff or student medical issue which must be accommodated. AC can be used in individual rooms if office, library, computer lab, staff room and funds can be raised for this.
 - -HWDSB is currently looking at implementing upper temperature limit (ie during heat advisories) which the school must be kept below, however there is currently only a lower limit requirement of 18degC
 - 3) asphalt condition- Mr Avery stated that the entire asphalt will not be considered for replacement until completion of the PRC in 2020. Only maintenance work can be undertaken before that time
 - -portions of the black top may be considered for upgrading as sports facility 4)water fountain lead testing- the fountain has been replaced and reopened and now testing negative for lead. All fixtures are flushed daily by care taker and YMCA program 5)outdoor lighting and security concerns- Mr. Avery will look into moving flood lights from front to back to cover black top and playground area
- 6. YMCA Before and After School Program Update- FDK- new room as of Feb 4

- 7. Dundas Valley Cooperative Pre-School Update- successful Mickey Mouse Disco held last week. Enrollment increased to 80% as of January
- 8. Principle's Update/ School Improvement Plans-
